What is DTSC Doing to Protect the Environment from Treated Wood Waste?

<u>Assembly Bill 1353 (2004, Matthews)</u> added Sections 25150.7 and 25150.8 to the Health and Safety Code. This law requires DTSC to adopt regulations specifying alternative management standards for treated wood waste.

Stakeholder Workshops on Net Costs and Payment Rates

CalRecycle's electronic waste recycling program will be holding two stakeholder workshops in May to discuss net cost information and explore whether any changes are necessary in the covered electronic waste (CEW) recovery and recycling payment rates.

The first workshop will be held in conjunction with the regular monthly meeting of the Material Management and Local Assistance (MMLA) Program on Wednesday, May 12, 2010. The general MMLA meeting begins at 10:00 a.m., and the electronic waste program portion will begin at approximately 11:00 a.m. and will last until 1:30 p.m. It is anticipated that a web-based audio broadcast will be available, as well as a conference call connection.

The second workshop will be held on Tuesday, May 25th beginning at 9:00 a.m.

At the May 12th meeting, staff will provide an overview of recent trends in the CEW program and present preliminary data received from the most recent cycle of Net Cost Reports. Stakeholders will be given the opportunity to share information with staff.

Program expects to have any decisions regarding payment rate adjustments finalized and announced at the June 16th MMLA monthly meeting.

Net Cost Report Noncompliance and Approval Revocations

All collectors and recyclers who had approved status in the covered electronic waste (CEW) recovery and recycling payment system in 2009 were required to submit Net Cost Reports covering their 2009 operations to CalRecycle on or before March 1, 2010. As of today, approximately 20 percent of approved participants have failed to submit a report. Most of those entities do not appear to have been active in the CEW payment system during 2009.

Failure to report is considered a prohibited activity that will result in approval revocation. Notifications will be transmitted within the next week.

A collector whose approval has been revoked may no longer act as a designated approved collector on behalf of a local government, nor manage source anonymous CEW. Approved recyclers are encouraged to determine the current status of



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
